Twill lift me, as it lifted thee, to reign with Christ above.

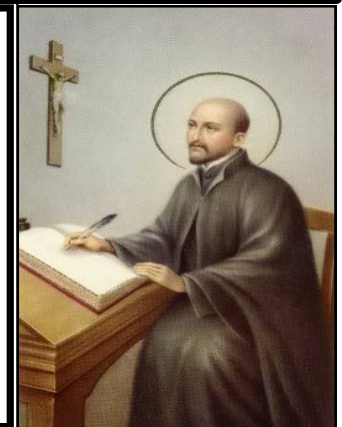
