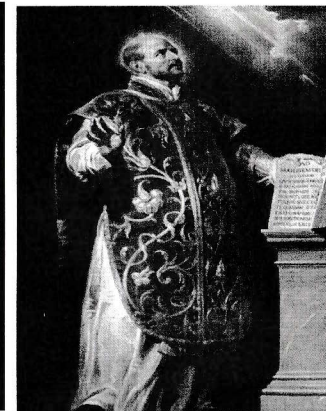

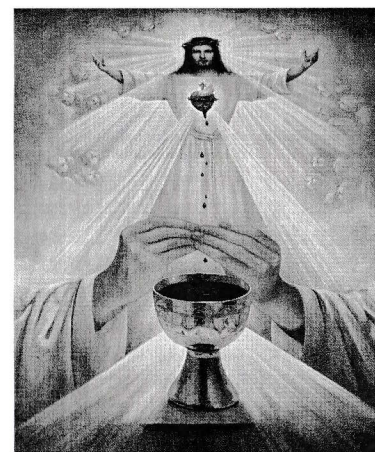

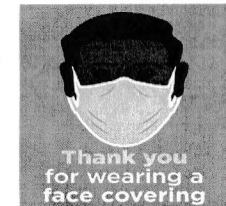
The Loyola Centre
