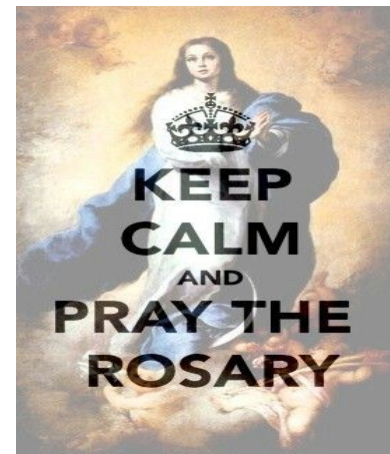

Centenary

On 18th May 1920 a baby boy was born to Karol & Emilia Wojtyla. He was named Karol Jozef(Jnr). We know him better as Pope John Paul II. He was elected to the Papacy in October 1978. After almost 27years, he died in 2005. Pope Francis declared him a saint of the Church in 2014 and his feast day is 22nd October. This was the day he was inaugurated Pope. On Monday 18th May 2020, we commemorate 100th anniversary of his birth.
