Dear Brothers and Sisters,
For sometime now, the situation has been getting worse.
We have seen the number of cases increase and sadly we have
also seen the number of deaths increase. This has to be taken
seriously and please follow the guidelines. The Scottish
Government has placed North Lanarkshire in Level 4. Places
of Worship will remain open but with restrictions:

All Masses are now limited to 20 people.
Funeral Masses and Baptisms are limited to 20 people.
Weddings are reduced to 15 people.

As a result we need to return to a booking system for
weekday Masses as well as Sunday Masses.
Please limit yourself to one Mass in order to allow others to
come to the celebration of the Eucharist. If you are able to
come to one of the weekday Masses, then I ask that you do
not book for a Sunday Mass, please leave this free for those
who are unable to come to weekday Masses due to work
commitments. If you are able to come to weekday Mass,
please think of others and DO NOT come to more than one
week day Mass. If you book for Mass please ensure that you
come to that Mass, a number of people failed to turn up last
weekend. I appreciate that things can happen, then please
inform someone that you are unable to attend. Please do not
book for Mass in an other parish. To book for Mass, please
call **07595860196** Thursday or Friday between 12noon & 6pm. Do
Not call the Chapel house.

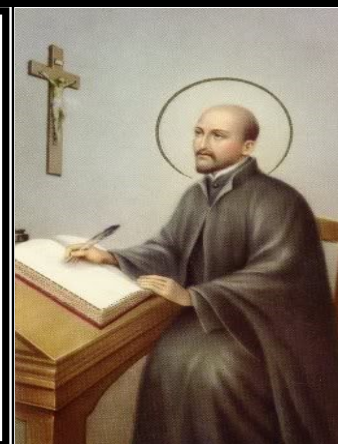
